Located in the medieval town of Todi, Cantina Tudernum was established in 1958 by 57 vineyard owners looking to produce and market wine together as a cooperative. By 1995, production spanned 650 hectares. That year, the co-op recognized the

potential of Todi (and greater Umbria) to produce quality wines.

They redeveloped with a focus on downsizing production and increasing quality, showcasing native Italian varietals, especially the brilliantly rare ones of Umbria.
