THE STORY

Krutz Family Cellars was founded in summer of 2003 when Patrick Krutz produced sixty cases of wine. The idea was to purchase grapes in order to produce a small amount of wine for family and friends. However, demand soon changed that plan and Krutz Family Cellars continues to grow.

PHILOSOPHY: We do our best to take a minimalistic approach to the winemaking to achieve varietally correct, balanced wines. Our brand is truly family owned and not a corporate driven label on the shelf.

BIOGRAPHY: Winemakers and brothers Patrick and Cole Krutz learned the art of winemaking from inside the cellar working with several prominent winemakers over the years. They are responsible for making over 50 total wines that have scored 90 points or higher.
