## THE STORY

The Lazcano family has been farming three separate single-vineyard plots for nearly a century. The estate was first founded by Andrés Lazcano back in 1923. At the time, Andrés made small amounts of Txakoli wines from vineyards located along his farmhouse and sold them to neighboring towns nearby. Since then, the winery has significantly expanded and is now on its fifth generation of winemakers, who continue to highlight the one-of-a-kind growing area of Getariako, where the family name is synonymous with pioneering of the region.

**PHILOSOPHY:** At Gaintza, respect and passion for the land always come first. In the cellar, emphasis is always placed on the preservation of regional traditions. The family's 25 hectares of organically farmed vines are all heavily influenced by the Cantabrian Sea.
